

What is Free World One?

Free World One is our new for-profit philanthropic company under which all our projects – and those of others we deem aligned with the Free World Charter ethos – can be supported, funded and grown.

Why is it a for-profit company?

Working on donations and good will has only brought us so far, but in order for us to really effect change, we need a much broader reach. Using the current profit-based system allows us to bridge the gap between where we are now and where we all want to be – in a free, more sustainable world – by developing and supporting profitable products that can take us there faster.

Where do your profits go?

Free World One is unique in that we're not here to get rich, we're here to drive change. That means all funds generated from our projects go straight back into developing more change-making projects, with profits distributed to shareholders.

What are some of these change-making projects?

In addition to existing projects Freeworlder, the global free-sharing network, and HonorPay, the awards and reputation site, we're also developing PlayUp Games, a series of educational activity books designed to teach children essential life skills such as empathy, compassion and cooperation.

We're also planning a screenplay production of Colin's popular book *F-Day: The Second Dawn of Man*. All of these projects have huge potential to not only effect change but also benefit shareholders like you.

Can anyone become a shareholder?
