

80-BALL BINGO – GAME RULES AND DESCRIPTION

OVERVIEW

80-ball bingo is like a cross between 75-ball and 90-ball bingo. Players opt in to an 80-ball bingo game by buying numbered bingo tickets. A caller calls out numbers randomly and if they appear on a player's ticket, the player covers them or 'daubs' them. Prizes are awarded for winning 1, 2 or 3 lines or a full house, with some games also awarding prizes for the four corners and the four middle squares.

80-BALL BINGO TICKET

80-ball bingo tickets consist of a 4x4 chart of 16 numbers.

WINNING PATTERN

In 80-ball bingo, prizes are awarded for 1, 2 or 3 horizontal, diagonal or vertical lines, a full house, and in some cases, the four corners and four middle squares.

PAYOUTS AND JACKPOTS

In most cases, the size of a game's payout is determined by the cost per card and the number of players who opted into the game. The higher the card price and the more players that join a game, the higher the prizes will be. Occasionally, there's a fixed minimum prize regardless of the number of players that participate and the price of the cards. Some bingo games also offer extra jackpots.

GAME OPTIONS

You can customise the bingo interface to suit your needs by selecting the Options button in the right corner of the screen. Simply pick the settings of your choice and click OK. You can always go back and change them at any point.

Available Settings:

Price Alert: Here you can choose to see the card prices within the bingo rooms.

Show 3TG: This stands for 'Show 3 to go', which, when selected, will highlight cards that only have 1, 2 or 3 numbers left to cover until you win.

Autodaub: If you select this setting, the system will automatically cover the called numbers on your card for you.

NOTE: Choosing not to autodaub will not affect the outcome of the game. If you have a winning bingo card, that win is yours, regardless of whether you've autodaubed or daubed yourself!

Best Card First: Displays your cards in order of closest to winning, with those closer coming first.

CARDS SELECTION

To play, you must buy at least one 80-ball bingo card, up to a maximum of 96 cards per game. Make sure you have sufficient funds in your account and check the price per card (at the top left of the screen, on each card, or at the purchase panel) before buying your cards.

Manual Selection of Cards

Choose the cards you want to buy by clicking on them. If you don't fancy the cards displayed, click 'Get New Cards' for a new selection.

Automatic Selection of Cards

If you prefer to have your cards chosen for you, click 'Auto Select Cards' and enter the number of cards you'd like, up to a maximum of 96. You can choose to remove specific cards here too.

PLAYING THE GAME

Once you've bought your tickets, all that's left to do is wait for the game to start! You can check when your next game starts by keeping an eye on the 'Game Starts' timer, which you'll find at the top of the screen. With new games starting every few minutes, you won't have to wait long!

Once the game starts, all your bingo cards will appear, along with details of the game, including the prize amounts, number of players and ways to win. The numbers will shortly start being called and they will also appear at the top, with the last 5 numbers called also being displayed so you can keep track.

DAUBING YOUR NUMBERS

Lots of players like to daub their own numbers, simply by moving their mouse over the called number on their card and clicking it to daub it. Many players prefer to take advantage of our Autodaub feature instead. This allows you to sit back and watch your cards fill up while our system automatically daubs the called numbers for you!

Autodaub is selected by default, but you can change it any time you like by going to the Options menu in the top left and removing the check mark next to 'Autodaub'.

Remember, regardless of whether or not you choose to Autodaub, if you have a winning bingo card, that prize is yours!

WINNING

If a player gets 1, 2 or 3 lines, a full house, or (if applicable) four corners or four inside squares, the game will pause briefly to display details of the winning player and the prize won.

Prize amounts depend on the price of the cards and the number of cards bought.

DISCONNECTIONS

Don't worry if you get disconnected during a game. Your cards will be autodaubed until you get back, and you'll still get any prizes that might result.
